

Ordering Concert Attire

2023-24 Children's Choruses

Members of the Cleveland Orchestra Children's Chorus will wear uniform concert attire for all performances. Basic uniform pieces are the same for members of the Children's Chorus and the Preparatory Chorus; this means that students who graduate from the Prep Chorus to the Children's Chorus from one year to the next can continue wearing the same uniform purchased in previous years, so long as all pieces still fit properly.

Required Uniform Garments:

- **ALL CHORISTERS:** Lay Down Collar Unisex Dress Shirt (\$16.00)
- Tuxedo Comfort Fit Trousers (\$26.00) **OR** Full Skirt (\$34.00)
 - Families must ensure that trousers and skirts are hemmed to the required guidelines mentioned below

Whether your child is new to our choruses or just hit a growth spurt, many of you will need to purchase new concert attire for your chorister. **Each family is responsible for purchasing concert attire for their own chorus members.** The exception to this would be families applying for financial assistance with uniform costs, in which case parents should be sure to submit the Financial Assistance Application while completing registration materials for the season.

If your child is **RETURNING** to our programs (DID sing with either the Prep Chorus or COCC last year), please take some time in the coming week to have your child **try on** all pieces of their concert uniform and confirm whether everything still fits properly.

Ordering Deadline – **No Later than Thursday, September 21st or Wednesday, March 27th**

- The Children's Choruses will be working with Formal Fashions Inc. this season.
- Garments may take **up to 2 weeks** to be shipped and delivered, so it is crucial that choristers order their garments **as early as possible** to ensure timely arrival.
- Also, skirts and trousers will need to be **hemmed after you receive the garments**. Families are responsible for ensuring that these items are hemmed to the required lengths.
- Examine your garments as soon as they arrive. The company has a **30-day** return policy, so please do not wait too long if you do need to return and replace an item.

Measuring Your Child & Hemming Requirements

Taking Measurements

1. Go to: www.formalfashionsinc.com
2. Click the **Videos** link in the navigation bar at the top of the page.
3. Scroll down to the video titled, **How to Measure**. This video will provide detailed instructions for taking the correct measurements.

Sizing Chart

1. Once you have your measurements, compare them to the size charts available for each garment.
2. Note that these are **not the same** as department store sizes; you **cannot** go by the size you typically wear.
3. Select the **largest size needed** to accommodate all measurements.
4. If you have questions or concerns about selecting the correct size, call 1-800-528-7909 to speak with a customer service representative.

Hemming – Required Skirt & Trouser Lengths

Many families are comfortable hemming the garments at home. However, you may hire a professional. Many dry-cleaning companies offer tailoring services.

- Skirts should be hemmed **11 inches from the ground** when **wearing dress shoes**.
- Trousers will also arrive **unhemmed**. Families are responsible for making sure they are hemmed to standard dress pant length. In general, socks should not be seen when standing. Trousers should also not drag on the floor.

LAY DOWN COLLAR UNISEX DRESS SHIRT - STYLE 2109BK

1. Go to www.formalfashionsinc.com
2. In the search box, type **2109BK**
3. Select **STYLE 2109 BK- Black Dress Shirt**
4. Use the size chart, and select the size that accommodates ALL of your child's measurements

FULL SKIRT – STYLE 502FAA-E

1. Go to www.formalfashionsinc.com
2. In the search box, type **502FAA-E**.
3. Select **STYLE 502FAA-E Full Skirt Floor Length**.
4. Use the size chart and select the size that accommodates ALL of your child's measurements.
5. This skirt will need to be **cut and hemmed** to the appropriate **11 inches from the ground** with dress shoes.

ADJUSTABLE DOUBLE PLEATED TUXEDO TROUSERS – STYLE 6502

1. Go to www.formalfashionsinc.com
2. In the search box, type **6502**.
3. Select **STYLE 6502 Adjustable Double Pleated Tuxedo Trousers**.
4. Use the size chart and select the size that accommodates ALL of your child's measurements.
5. These pants will arrive **unhemmed and** will need to be hemmed to the standard dress pant length. In general, socks should not be seen when standing. Trousers should also not drag on the floor.



Checking Out Details

- When checking out, enter ***Cleveland Orchestra Children's Choruses*** under ***school/company***. Representatives at Formal Fashions are on the lookout for our members' orders to ensure that everything is ordered as specified, and to better assist you should you have any questions throughout the ordering process.
- Enter ***October 21st, 2023*** or ***April 27th, 2024*** for the ***performance date***. These are the dates of our first concerts of each semester.

Additional Uniform Pieces

Families are responsible for securing the following items:

- Opaque black tights/nylons for choristers wearing skirts.
 - Note: we should not see feet! Leggings, footless tights, etc., are not appropriate concert attire.
- Black dress socks for choristers wearing trousers.
- Plain black dress shoes. All dress shoes should have little to no heel.

Shoes should be understated **with no jewels, glitter, or other distracting embellishments**. Appropriate examples of shoes include the following:



Children's Chorus members will be fitted for a blazer and Preparatory Chorus members will be fitted for a vest. These items will be worn for a majority of performances. Blazers and vests are property of the Cleveland Orchestra Chorus Office and **must be returned** at the end of the season. Fittings will take place in the early fall beginning at the first rehearsal, with additional details to come via email.
